Situation Analysis

 Despite large investments, teacher training has not significantly improved student learning outcomes. Indonesian students still score low in reading, math, and science compared to global standards.

The 2022 PISA results show slight gains from the Emergency Curriculum, but Indonesian students still fall behind regional peers, learning far less than their years in school suggest. 

 Based on the 2024 National Survey on Children's and Adolescents' Life Experiences, many children still experience various forms of violence throughout their lives: 18% physical violence, 45% emotional violence, and 9% sexual violence.

Climate change disrupts education through school closures and displacement—integrating climate education at home, in schools, and communities is key to lasting change.

KREASI – Collaboration for the Education of Indonesian Children is a program of the Government of Indonesia, funded by the **Global Partnership for Education (GPE) Multiplier Grant**, by leveraging the investment of the Australian Government's Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade for INOVASI Phase 3 Program. KREASI Program is implemented from October 1, 2024 - June 30, 2028.

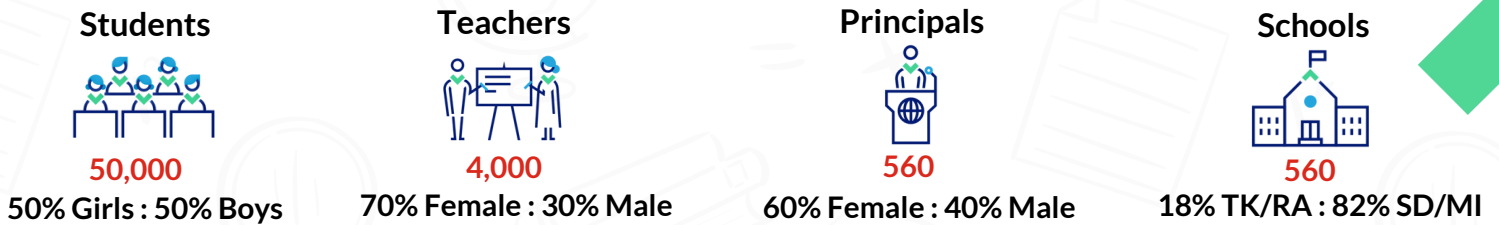

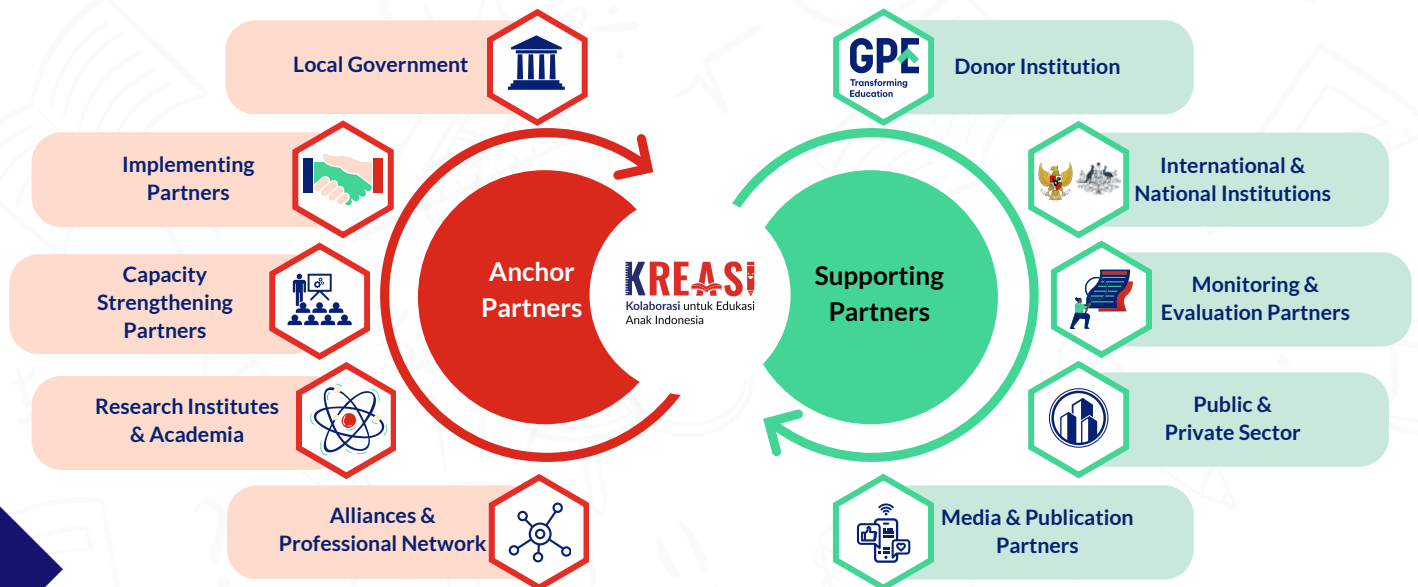
